ERRIGAL COUNTRY HOUSE HISTORY

Errigal House was built circa 1830 by Thomas Coote, the son of Charles, Earl of Bellamont of Bellamont Forest, Cootehill. The Coote family came to the area during the seventeenth century when Sir Charles Coote, a Cromwellian general, received grants of land in this area.

The original name of the house was "Fort William", through it now takes its name from the town land in which it is situated, Errigal.

The original house was Georgian in design, but was later modified and enlarged in the 1880's in Tudor Revival style. The front of the house, which survives in the present hotel, dates from this period.

Originally the house had two gate lodges, one opposite to the original entrance, with another closer to Cootehill.

Behind the house, which was surrounded by parkland, were stone farm buildings including labourers' cottages.

A rath, or ring fort, which is situated on the hill behind the hotel, indicates early human activity along the Annalee River. This rath measures c.32m on its internal diameter.

The building had numerous owners after being sold by the Coote family, including the Mooreheads, a doctor's family.

At different stages it was the rectory for the Church of Ireland minister in Ematris / Clones as well as the residence of the curate of Kill. R.C. Church.

The last residence was the family of Gary Hoban, who managed the AI station which was located in the house and its grounds during the 1960s.

Hotel Properties Act 1963

Damage to, or loss or destruction of, guest's property.

Under the Hotel Properties Act 1963 the proprietor of a hotel, as defined by the Act, may in certain circumstances be liable to make good damage to, or loss or destruction of a guest's property even though it was not due to any fault of the proprietor or staff of the hotel.

This Liability, however –

- Extends only to the property of person who have engaged sleeping accommodation at the hotel
- Is limited to €100 in the case of any one person, except in the case of motor vehicles and of property which has been deposited, or offered for deposit for safe custody

A hotel as defined by the Hotel Proprietors Act 1963 is an establishment which provides or hold itself out as providing sleeping accommodation, food and drink for reward all comers without special contract and includes every establishment registered as a hotel with Bord Fáilte Éireann.

Fire Evacuation Procedure

Errigal CountryHouse Hotel has installed a sophisticated fire alarm and smoke detection system that monitors all parts of the building.

Fire instruction notices are prominently displayed on the back of the bedroom door. May we suggest that you take a few moments to read the instructions and familiarise yourself with the location of the nearest exit.

SAFETY & SECURITY

If you discover a fire:

Use the nearest telephone to contact the Front Desk (Dial 0). Clearly state the location of the fire, giving the floor and room number nearest to the fire location as reference.

Do not panic.

Or

Activate the fire alarm button located next to the emergency fire exit. A signal which will pinpoint the location will automatically be relayed to the fire panel. A fire alarm will then be activated. Upon hearing the contiguous alarm you are requested to:

- Proceed to the nearest emergency exit or stairs
- Close all doors behind you
- Do not stop to collect any belongings
- Do not use or wait for any hotel lift as they will be automatically called to the ground level and will be immobilised
- Do not fight any fires
- Evacuate the area via the indicated fire escape
- Proceed to the designated assembly area at the front of the hotel where management will conduct a guest and team head count
- Do not re-enter the building until instructed by a Fire Officer

Bomb Scare

In the event of a bomb scare, you will be advised to evacuate the building. Please remain calm and leave the area of the building using the nearest fire exit. Proceed to the designated assembly area at the front of the hotel where management will conduct a guest and team head count.

Do not use or wait for any hotel lift as they will be automatically called to the ground floor level and will be immobilised.

Please report all suspicious parcels or persons to the nearest security personnel or to team member. Please do not touch the parcels or approach suspicious persons.
